Administration

Staff continues working on the annual commercial billing process and determining the charges based on water usage.

Staff prepared and submitted the required Government Compensation Report to the State Controller's Office.

Staff completed the annual CASA Salary and Benefits Survey.

Staff prepared the 3rd Quarter FY 2019-2020 Financial Report.

Staff attended Personnel and Finance Committee Meetings.

Staff continues work on the FY 2020-2021 Budget Document.

Staff attended the City of Santa Barbara Planning Commission Hearing regarding the renewal of the Coastal Development Permit. A couple of days prior to the hearing Staff and Patsy Price from BHFS met with the Commission at the GWSD headquarters for a site visit. That went well and the Commission approved the CDP renewal on April 16th.

Staff prepared and sent out the Annual Recycled Water Report for calendar year 2019. This report must be provided annually to the Regional Water Quality Control Board due to the District being permitted to use recycled water for street sweeping.

Collection System

The Phelps Road Project continues. Both the Storke /Phelps and Los Carneros/Mesa intersections are now paved and striped. Construction continues moving west on Phelps Road. No issues at this time.

The crew continues with the routine sewer line cleaning schedule. Cleaning is currently being worked on in the Evergreen area. The crew also completed hotspots and root cutting throughout the District for the month of April & May 2020. A sewer operations summary is enclosed with this operations report.

The crew completed CCTV inspections in the EMID area. This completes regularly scheduled CCTV work included in the 2020 preventative maintenance program.

The crew completed the scheduled monthly maintenance and equipment exercising for April 2020.

Staff continues to inspect and document Toro Enterprises constructing private sewer improvements for four new commercial buildings at Cabrillo Business Park (CBP).

Staff is corresponding with the project engineer to finalize revisions to record drawings for the public portion of the Village at Los Carneros sewer system.

Staff completed a Sewer Service Permit for a garage conversion to an ADU at 6876 Sabado Tarde.

Staff issued Sewer Service Permits for trenchless sewer lateral replacements at 228 Daytona Drive, and 7363 Freeman Place.

Staff took delivery of a new CCTV push camera and received operation and maintenance training from the vendor.

Staff corresponded with CSRMA and their consultants regarding required safety training topics and utilization of instructional resources available through CSRMA.

Staff received safety training on the following topics: 2020 1st Quarter Safety Inspection findings and discussion; and the Gorman Rupp portable trash pump operation, maintenance, and safety.

Industrial Waste

Staff correspondence continues with the GSD consultant working on Pretreatment Program updates and a Technically Based Local Limits study. Staff is providing laboratory results data and other industrial user information.
