Updating the District's Facilities Master Pan is nearing completion.

Looking 20 years into the future, the Master Plan provides directions for effective maintenance, upgrades and replacement of facilities.

The Facilities Master Plan is a key tool to ensure continued safe, reliable and effective sanitary service.

PRO-ACTIVE

Here are a few examples of the District's pro-active maintenance planning:

- Clean pipelines every I to 3 years as needed.
- Maintain a root-cut schedule for pipe sections where needed.
- Regularly inspect manholes, pumps and emergency equipment.
- Carry out preventive maintenance for pumps, valves, generators, vehicles and other equipment.



Proactive Approach Benefits Customers and the Environment

The District's proactive approach to preventive maintenance is benefiting customers and protecting the environment by virtually eliminating sewer spills and overflows. The District has used advanced technology to achieve this success.



 Combination Sewer Cleaning Machine— A special machine cleans the inside of sewer lines with water jets at a pressure of 2,000 pounds per square inch. Attachments cut roots and vacuum out the lines.

> • Computerized Geographical Information System (GIS)—This system maps all of the District's pipelines, manholes and other facilities. It works in tandem with the

A computer system and database system increases efficiency. increases efficiency. provide a visual depiction of all facilities, as well as data on the entire sewer collection system.

• Closed-Circuit Television— A special video camera photographs the inside of sewer pipelines. The video truck reveals details of any problems in the lines. This helps determine which sections require maintenance, rehabilitation or replacement and how urgent is the need. This costeffective approach helps protect the environment, and assist the District to comply with rigorous regulations.

• **Computerized Operations Database**—This database assists the District to manage and maintain District facilities. It stores important data that can then be easily retrieved: facility inventories, maintenance history, age and type of pipe, location and more.


Help Keep Your Drains Fat Free
