# Districting Criteria

## Required:

- Relatively equal in population
- In compliance with the Federal Voting Rights Act

## Recommended:

- Contiguous
- Easily identifiable and understandable lines, following city, natural, and man-made boundaries
- Keep districts compact – appearance/function

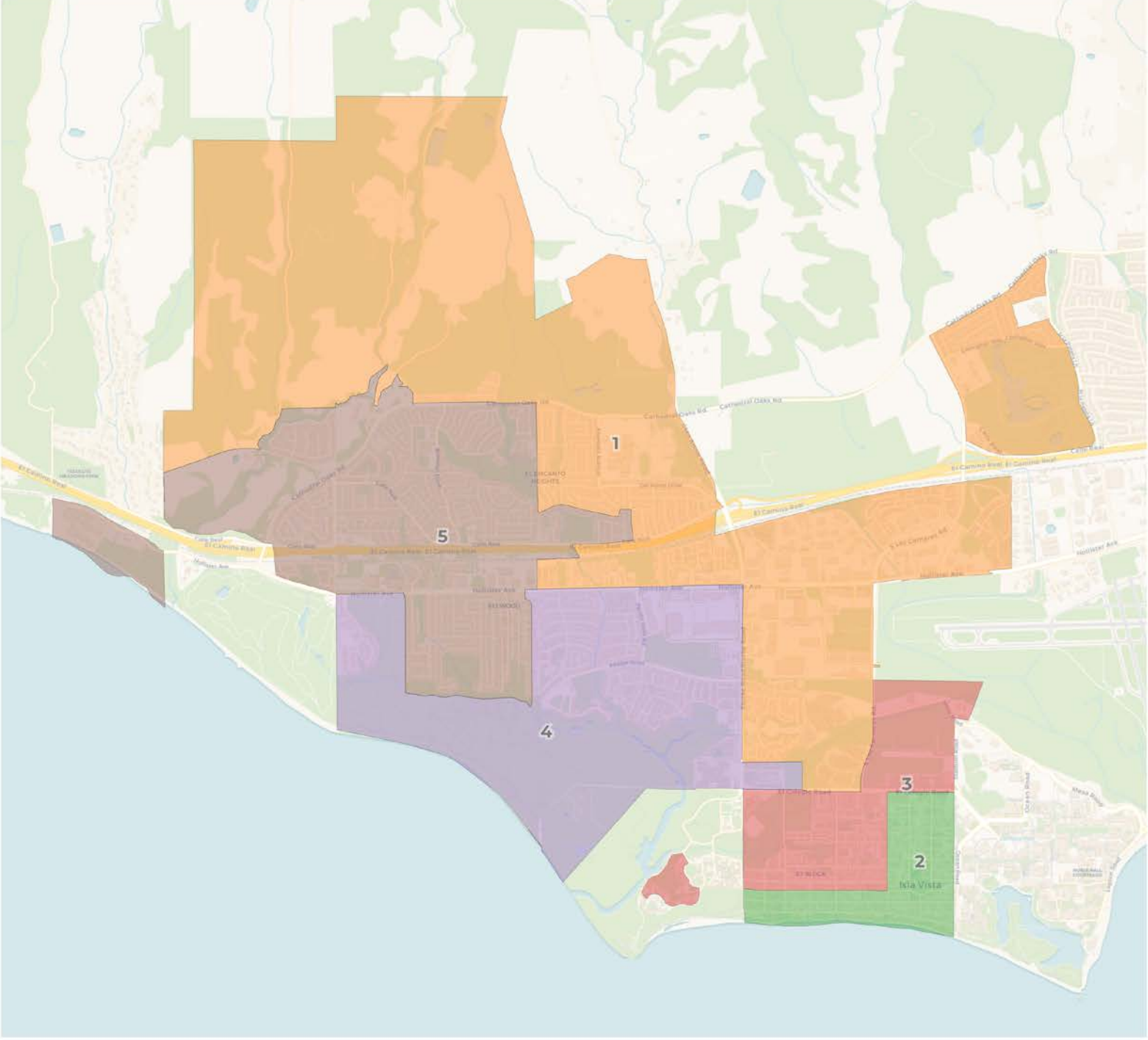

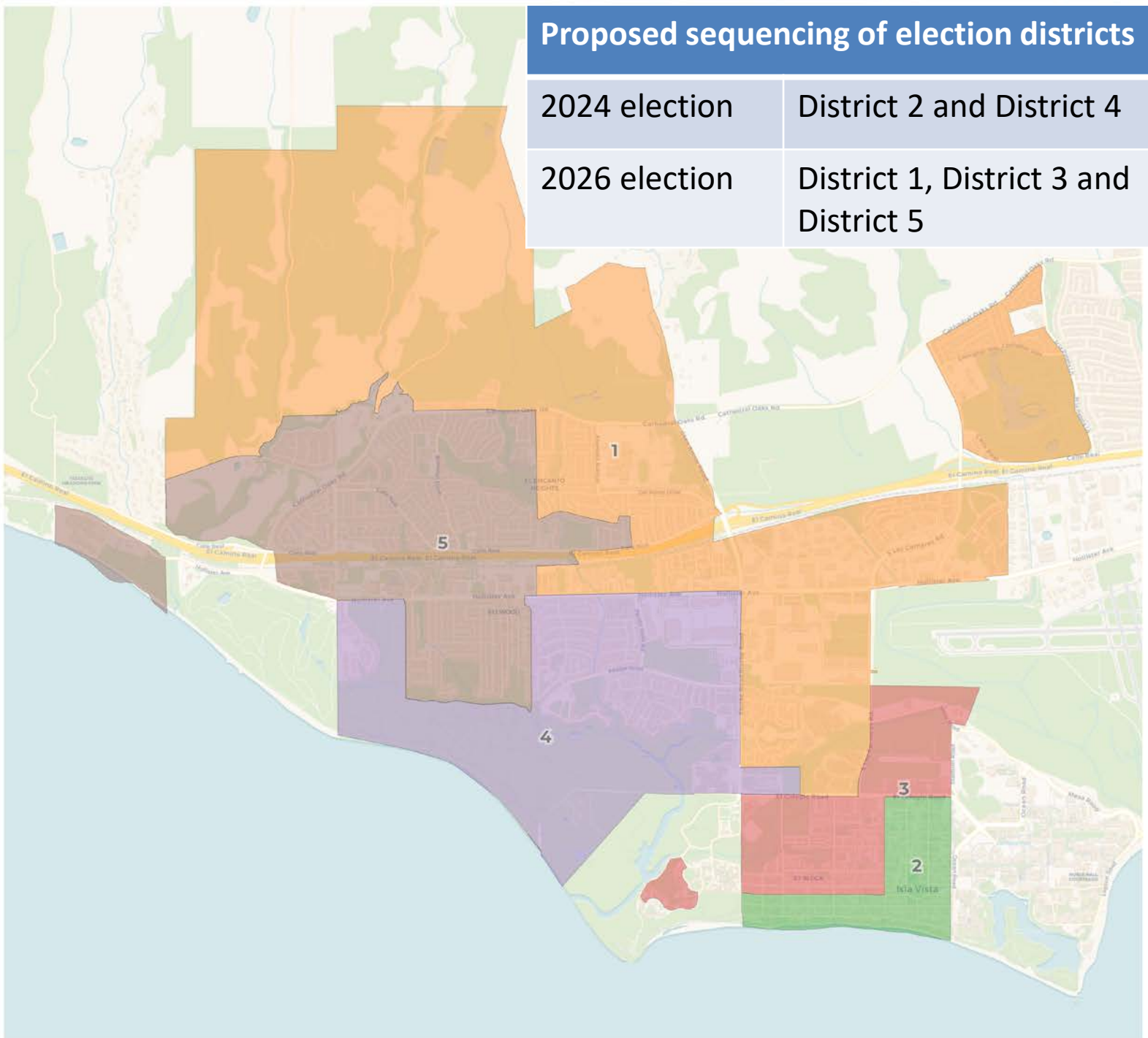
## Proposed sequencing of election districts

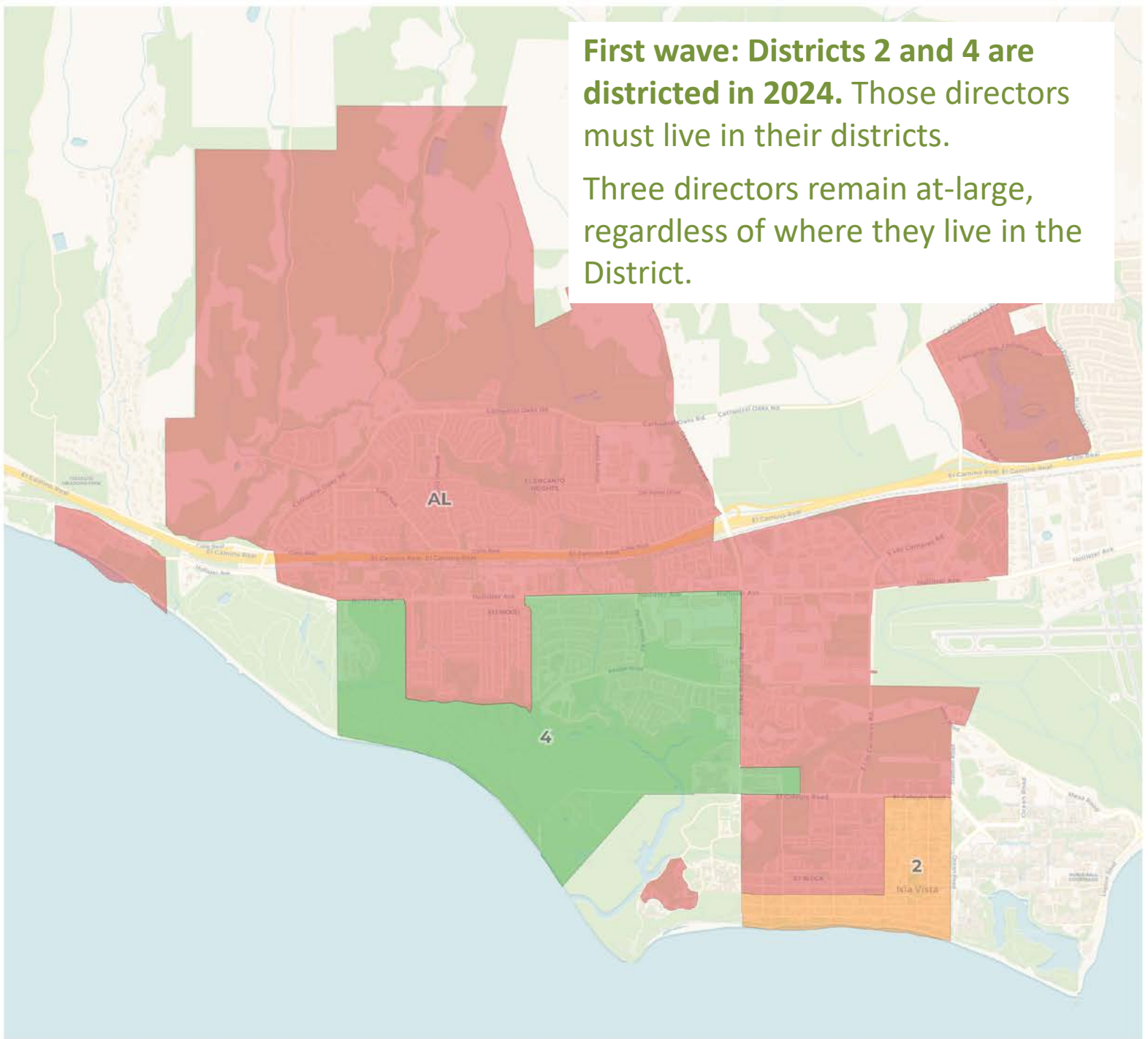
2024 election

District 5

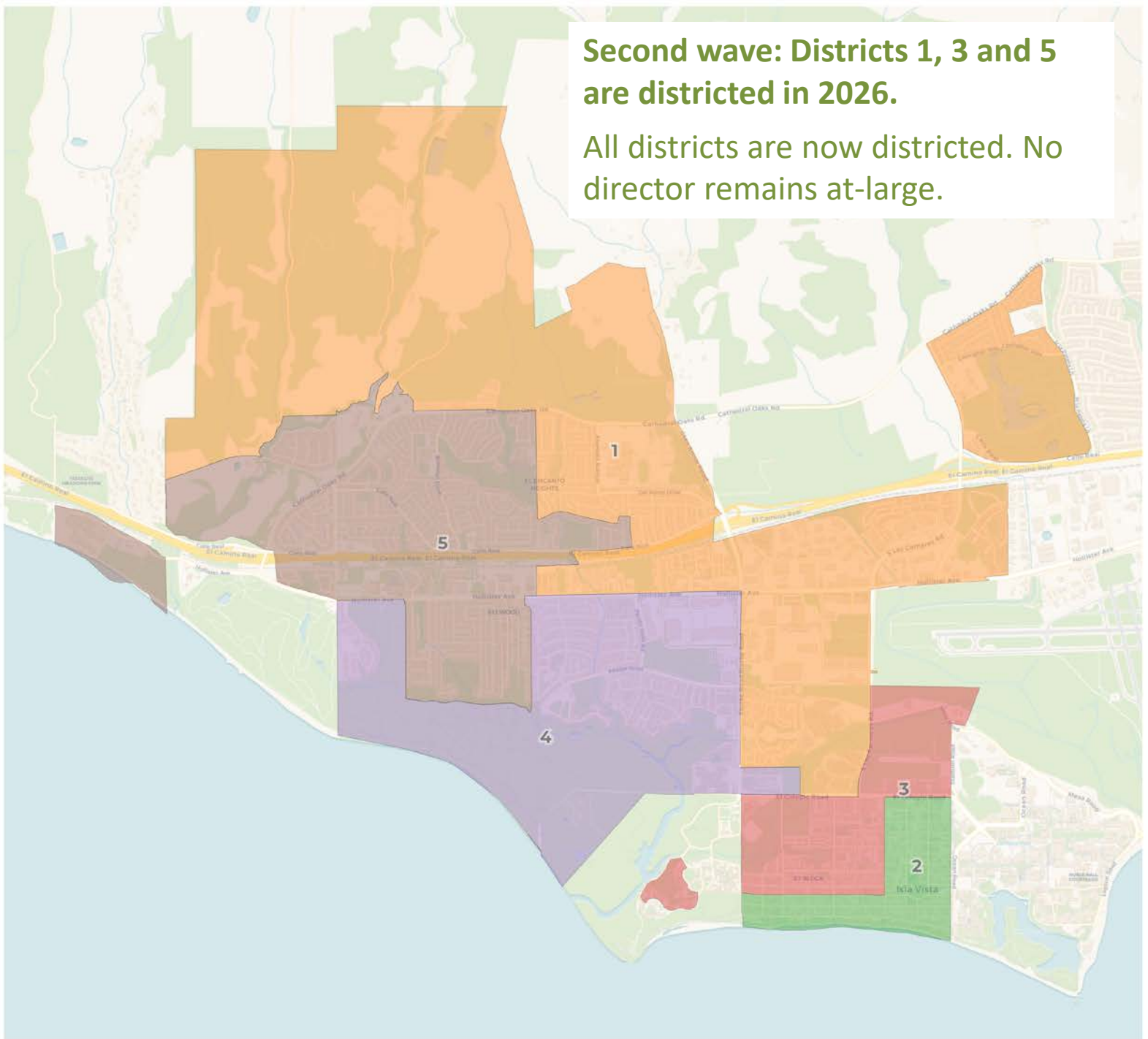




**First wave: Districts 2 and 4 are districted in 2024.** Those directors must live in their districts.

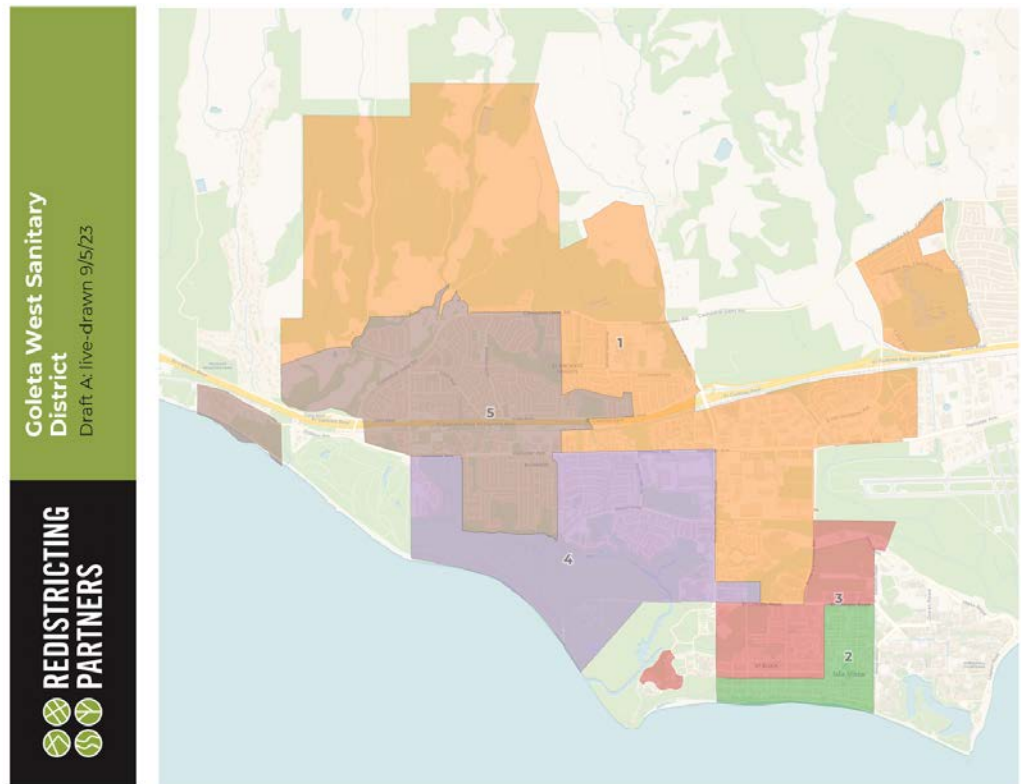
Three directors remain at-large, regardless of where they live in the District.
