Candidates for this position must be registered voters residing within District 2 of Goleta West Sanitary District, be at least 18 years of age, and not have convictions for specified crimes.

Serving on the board will require a commitment to attend Board Meetings, which are held once or twice a month, and Committee Meetings. Other requirements include, but are not limited to, completing Ethics Training (per AB 1234), Sexual Harassment Training (per AB 1825), and filing an annual Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700).
