Districting Criteria

Required:

- Relatively equal in population
- In compliance with the Federal Voting Rights Act

Recommended:

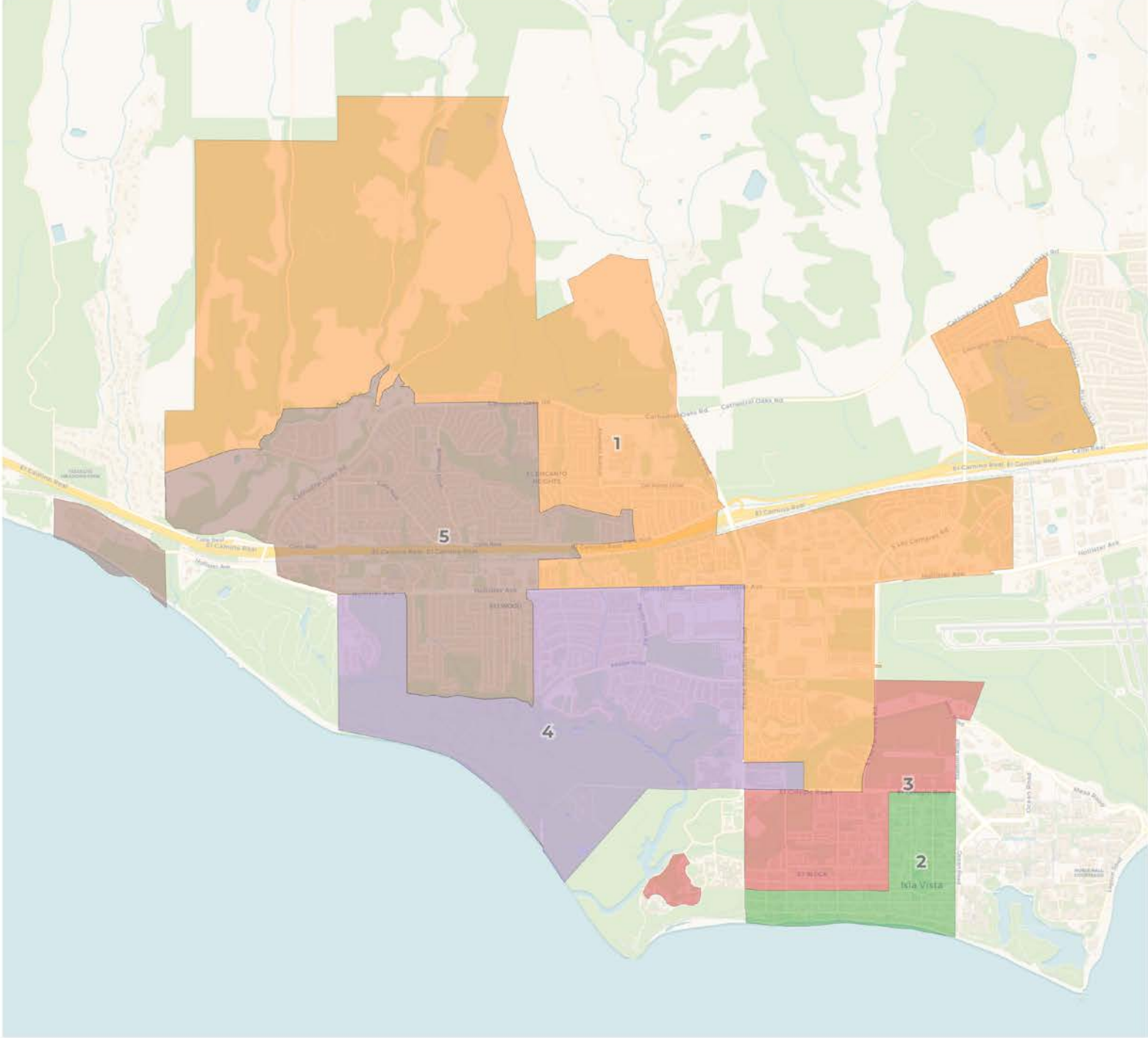
- Contiguous
- Easily identifiable and understandable lines, following city, natural, and man-made boundaries
- Keep districts compact – appearance/function

Sequencing of Election Districts

Sequencing determines when each district is up for election, and then residents will vote in those districts every four years thereafter. Two districts will be scheduled for 2024 and three districts will be scheduled for 2026.

How to determine sequencing:

- Hear input from the public, if any
- Staff will create a proposed sequencing schedule in a way that will be least disruptive to the natural election cycle.

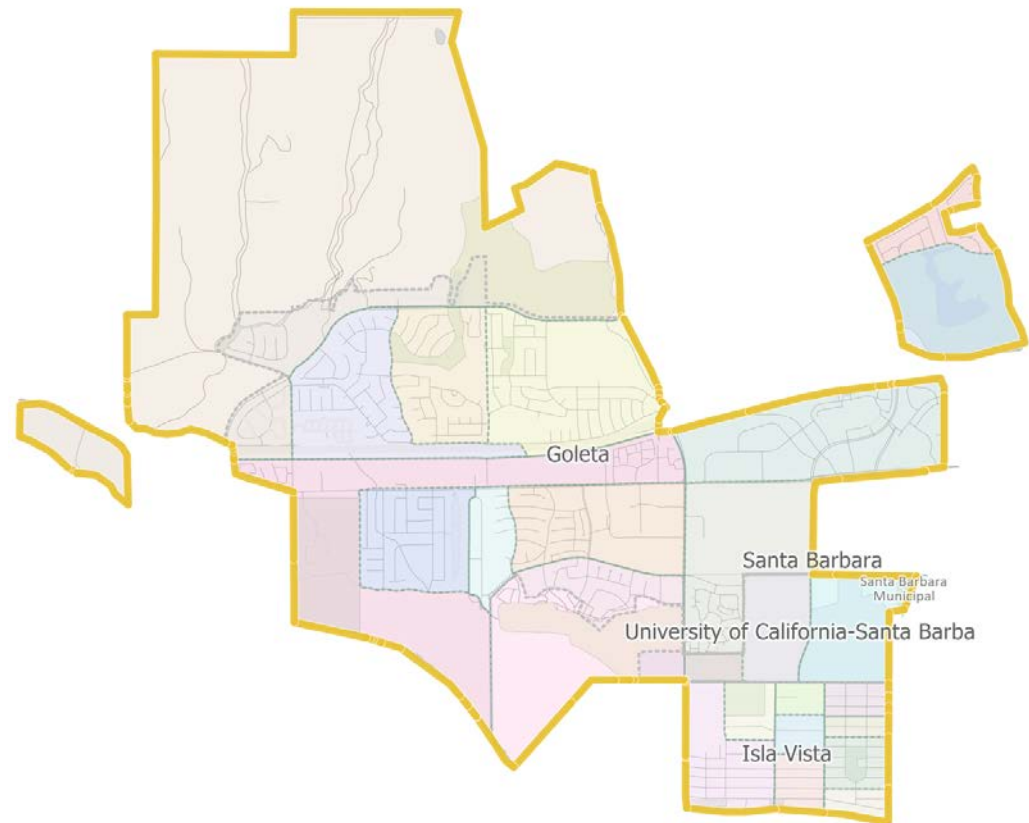
Public Hearing #4: Draft Maps
