9. THE BOARD WILL RECEIVE AN UPDATE FROM ED GALINDO, ARCHITECT, ON THE STATUS OF PHASE 2 OF THE HEADQUARTER BUILDINGS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT # 13-02 NEW ADMINISTRATION BUILDING

Architect Edwardo Galindo of EGA will provide an update to the Board on the status of Phase 2 of the Headquarter Building Improvements – New Administration Building.

10. THE BOARD WILL RECEIVE A CYBERSECURITY PRESENTATION FROM SIMON BENTLEY, THE DISTRICT IT CONSULTANT

The District's IT consultant Simon Bentley from CITIG will provide a Cybersecurity presentation to the Board and make recommendations for updating the District's security measures to current best practices.

11. RECONSIDERATION OF THE CONDITIONS CONSTITUTING AN EMERGENCY

The Board adopted Resolution 24-823, declaring an emergency pursuant to Public Contract Code sections 20806 and 22050, to allow an immediate response to a sewage spill. The Board will review the conditions warranting an emergency and will, by a 4/5 vote, make a determination on whether there is a need to continue the action.

12. CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. 24-824 ORDERING AN ELECTION AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION WITH THE STATEWIDE ELECTION AND RESOLUTION NO. 24-825 GOVERNING CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The Board will consider adopting Resolution No. 24-824 ordering an election on November 5, 2024 to fill District seats 2 and 4 and requesting the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors consolidate said election with the statewide election occurring on the same date. In addition, the Board will consider Resolution No. 24-825, which establishes rules for candidate statements of qualification.

13. CONSIDERATION OF THE DISTICT PUBLIC AGENCY RETIREMENT SYSTEM (PARS) OPEB AND PENSION TRUST PROGRAMS REVIEW

The Finance Committee met with representative from PARS on May 15, 2024. The Committee and the PARS team are recommending that no changes be made to the PARS OPEB and Pension Trust Programs for FY 2024-25.

14. CONSIDERATION OF SENDING LETTER IN SUPPORT OF H.R. 7944, THE WATER SYSTEMS PFAS LIABILITY PROTECTION ACT

The Board will consider directing the General Manager to send a letter per CASA's recommendation in response to the recent USEPA PFOA and PFOS Hazardous Substances CERCLA Designation Final Rule. The final

rule lacks explicit liability protections for public water and wastewater utilities, as well as biosolids management.

15. CONSIDERATION OF SPONSORING THE ANNUAL GOLETA LEMON FESTIVAL

The Annual Goleta Lemon hosted by the South Coast Chamber of Commerce is scheduled for September 28th and 29th at Girsh Park. The District typically supports this event and, in the past, has provided sponsorship at the middle tier level. This level of support displays the Districts logo prominently throughout the Festival. The District also receives an event booth which historically has been donated to Heal the Ocean to promote our shared interest in protecting the water environment.
