What Not to Flush Your toilet is not a trash can.

Do Not Flush...

- Antibacterial wipes - they harm the aquatic environment and block sewer lines, pumps and other facilities - Put antibacterial wipes in the trash!
- "Flushable" diapers - they get stuck on roots that have infiltrated sewer lines. Put disposable diapers in the trash!
- Plastics or cellophane - Put them in the trash!
- Toxic chemicals, pesticides, or paints - Take them to a household hazardous waste facility.
- Pharmaceuticals - Find an authorized disposal site.
- Cigarettes or matches. Use an ashtray.

If you are caught short due to toilet paper being scarce, and find yourself using wipes, paper towels, etc...please throw them away. Do not flush them or you may experience plumbing back-ups.

Phelps Road Sewer Trunk Line

We began construction on the Phelps Road sewer Trunk Line Project in early August 2019 and completed the project last month. This completes our efforts to upgrade hydraulic efficiencies in our system, remove infrastructure out of the Storke Wetland environmentally sensitive habitat and returns the habitat to its native state.

On behalf of our Board of Directors and staff, we'd like to thank our customers and those who may have been inconvenienced by the construction of this important project for your patience and understanding. We hope you appreciate the necessity of continuing to maintain our system and the benefits that this project will provide by reducing the likelihood of sewer spills, improving the long term reliability of the system and providing protection to the environment and our surrounding sensitive habitats.
